FEATURED SPEAKERS



Dr. Gary Brans

Dr. Gary received his Ph.D. in urban entomology from Purdue University. He worked for Bayer CropScience for 21 years, focusing on urban pest problems in the Midwest. Recently, he founded Yosemite Environmental Services, a company providing services on research, training, technology transfer and legal support in the pest management industry. Dr. Brans authored book chapters on Insecticide and Pesticide Safety in the *Mallis Handbook of Pest Control*, 8th, 9th and 10th editions.



Dr. James Campbell

Dr. Campbell is a research entomologist with the USDA-ARS Grain Marketing and Production Research Center in Manhattan, Kansas. He received his Ph.D. in entomology from the University of California-Davis. His research focuses on the behavior and ecology of stored-product insect pests and uses this information to improve pest management programs.



Colonel (Dr.) Mustapha Debboun

Colonel Debboun received his Ph.D. in medical entomology from the University of Missouri-Columbia. He currently is Chief of the Department of Preventive Health Services, AHS, AMEDDC&S. He has worked in public health and preventive medicine operations, research and development of arthropod repellents. His assignments have taken him to over 25 different countries in Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, and South America. He has published 75 papers and three books on Insect Repellents, Prevention of Bug Bites, Stings and Disease. He is nationally and internationally known for his repellent research.



Ms. Gail Getty

Ms. Getty received her B.S. in entomology and M.S. in wood science & technology from the University of California-Berkeley. She has over 16 years of experience in conducting scientific research on urban insect biology, ecology, chemical ecology and behavior. She has published 21 scientific papers. Her projects have involved major manufacturing companies. She has been an expert witness in bed bug, termite, beetle, and construction defect lawsuits. Recently, Ms. Getty formed the Getty Entomological Research and Consulting Company.



Dr. Roger Gold

Dr. Gold, former Entomology Department Chair at UNL, is currently the Endowed Chair in urban entomology at Texas A&M University. He has won numerous awards and written more than 200 research and extension publications. His research emphasis is on the integrated pest management of insects associated with humans and their companion animals, with specific work on ants, cockroaches and termites. His work stresses mechanical/physical, biological and chemical control of insect pest populations.



Mr. Jerry Heath

Mr. Jerry Heath received a B.S. in entomology from Washington State University. As a product manager and entomologist at the Industrial Fumigant Company, he is involved with product marketing and technical services for the food processing and commodity industries. He has also worked on insect growth regulators and pheromone mating disruption products for stored grain pests.



Dr. Tom Janousek

Dr. Janousek received his B.S. from Creighton University in Omaha and Ph.D. from Texas A&M University. He was a post-doctoral researcher at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln for a few years and conducted research on mosquitoes. He is a Major in the U.S. Army Reserve. Dr. Janousek formed a company in 1999 called Pest Consulting Services, based in Omaha. Dr. Janousek has been monitoring the West Nile virus for a few years. He has traveled extensively to assist with mosquito abatement programs.



Dr. Michael Rust

Dr. Michael Rust is a professor of Urban Entomology at the University of California in Riverside. He received his Ph.D. in entomology from the University of Kansas. For over 25 years, his research has been focused on cockroaches, ants and termites. His book, "Understanding and Controlling the German Cockroach", is well recognized. He has published numerous papers and was rewarded with many national awards.



Dr. Michael Scharf

Dr. Scharf received his M.S. and Ph.D. in urban entomology and insect toxicology from Purdue University. He was Director of the Industrial Affiliates Program in the Urban Entomology Center at Purdue University and then from 2004-2010, he was an Assistant and Associate Professor in Insect Molecular Toxicology at the University of Florida. In 2010, Dr. Scharf re-joined Purdue University as the Orkin Endowed Chair in Urban Entomology and Molecular Physiology. He is internationally known for his molecular and toxicology research on cockroaches, termites and bed bugs.
