Use Restrictions

Apply this product only as specified on this label. Only protected applicators may be in treatment area during application.

Storage and Disposal

STORAGE: Store in a cool, dry area. Store unused portion in an airtight, sealed container.

CONTAINER HANDLING: Non-refillable container. If empty: Place in trash. If partly filled: Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions.

Directions for Use

TechDust® may be applied with a hand or power duster. Dust may be injected into areas where insects tunnel or nest using a bulb applicator. To be used in and around livestock premises, including: poultry operations, dairy barns, calf hutches, horse barns, swine quarters, pens and shelters and other associated areas where insect control is necessary. Product use permitted in other areas or facilities when product is used according to label directions.

To Treat an Outbreak

Dust can be applied during an outbreak while animals are present. Prior to application, turn off cooling and evacuation fans. Keep fans off until dust has settled (about 15 minutes). DO NOT remain in treated area after application. Wait until product has settled to return to the area.

 Apply 2.5 to 3.25 lbs per 1,000 sq. ft. using a backpack blower to all surfaces in the house especially areas where roaches are known to harbor, approximately 30 to 40 pounds per 12,000 sq. ft. house. Apply as needed using a bulb or hand applicator to areas between and around double studs ensuring that all internal surfaces are coated.

When used in dairy barns or facilities, close milk bulk tank lids to prevent contamination. Reapply as needed.

For Preventative Use

Apply product in the same manner as above for outbreak treatment. Apply monthly, after cleanouts, if infestation levels rise or prior to placement of new animals. Spot treat areas of the house where roaches congregate.
