APPLICATION DIRECTIONS:

The active ingredient in this product is different from anticoagulant rodenticides. Individual mice cease feeding after consuming a toxic dose.

House Mice: Place bait stations 8 to 12 feet apart in infested areas. Highest bait consumption is expected to occur on the first day or two after treatment. After several days, inspect bait placements and mouse activity. Continue baiting until all signs of house mouse activity have ceased.

FOLLOW-UP: Replace contaminated or spoiled bait immediately. While wearing gloves, collect and properly dispose of all dead house mice and used bait station. To discourage reinfestation, limit sources of rodent food, water, and harborage as much as possible. If reinfestation does occur, repeat treatment.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Do not contaminate water, food or feed by storage or disposal.

Pesticide Storage: Store in original container in a cool, dry place inaccessible to children and pets. Keep containers closed and away from other chemicals.

Pesticide Disposal: Dispose of wastes resulting from the use of this product in trash or at an approved waste disposal facility.

Container Handling, Nonrefillable container: Do not reuse or refill this container.

Dispose of empty container by placing in trash, at an approved waste disposal facility, or by incineration. Do not burn, unless allowed by state and local ordinances.

Sub-lethal symptoms, if present, would be the result of cerebral edema and should be treated accordingly through administration of an osmotic diuretic and corticosteroid.

USE SITES: For indoor and outdoor use. This product may only be used to control house mice in and around homes and residential buildings.

USE RESTRICTIONS:

This bait station may be used in areas accessible to children and pets, consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated on this label. Do not apply further than 50 feet from home or building. For control only of house mice. This bait station can only be refilled with the block bait sold with this station. This bait station must be used in and around buildings consistent with all use restrictions and other requirements indicated on this label. Do not place this bait station or stored block bait in any area where there is a possibility of contaminating food or surfaces that come into direct contact with food. Store Bait Block® refills out of reach of children and pets.

SELECTION OF TREATMENT AREAS: Determine areas where house mice will most likely find and consume the bait. Generally, these areas are along walls, by gnawed openings, in corners and concealed places, between floors and walls, or in locations where rodents or their signs have been seen. Remove as much alternative food as possible.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR OPENING, REFILLING & RECLOSING THE MOUSE BAIT STATION

1. To open the Bait Station, put on gloves and insert the plastic key into the lock on top of the Bait Station lid. Push the key all the way down into the lock and turn key in the direction of the arrow to open the station lid.
2. REMOVE AND SAVE THE KEY
3. Remove the plastic bait holder and discard any remaining bait from both the holder and the bait station. Place one refill block of bait into each side of the plastic bait holder, with center holes facing upward.



4. Insert plastic bait holder with two refill baits into the MIDDLE COMPARTMENT of the Bait Station as shown below.
