The Agency, in accordance with the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide and Rodenticide Act (FIFRA), as amended, has completed reviewing all of the information submitted with your application to support the reregistration of the above referenced product in connection with the **Permethrin** REDs and has concluded that your submission is acceptable

NOTE This product is **not** being reregistered under sections 3(c) 5 and 4(g) of FIFRA at this time
